In an effort to streamline the CCW process from start to finish and improve the delay for CCW appointments, the Stanislaus County Sheriff's Office has implemented a new automated system for the processing of CCW permits. This online system will allow applicants to fill out applications, make a payment with credit card(s) and schedule their own appointments. It will also allow applicants to monitor the progress of their permit application without having to call in to the CCW Unit. The new system will also allow for the ability to submit requests for permit modifications such as change of address, name change and weapon(s) changes.

Those applicants who currently have an existing CCW appointment with our previous online calendar will not have to select a new appointment. We will honor the appointment already scheduled. Applicants will be contacted and directed to log into our website at <https://www.scsdonline.com/records/ccw-appointment.html> to submit their application, pay their fees and transition to our paperless, automated CCW system.

Those applicants needing a CCW renewal may also visit our website and submit their CCW application and applicable fees. An appointment is no longer necessary for renewals as the process has been streamlined for increased efficiency. We will honor those renewal appointments already scheduled in the previous calendar system. Applicants needing to renew their CCW permits need to submit their fees and application 60 days prior to the expiration date of their permit.
