Data cover the last 180 days from 30 days prior to today. Incident locations are deliberately offset to the nearest and intersection node to protect the privacy of parties involved in the incident.

Window Header Top Row Navigation

- A. **ZOOM** Click to zoom & scroll in or out.
- B. A HOME EXTENT Click on this icon to reset your map back to view the entire County.
- C. OMY LOCATION allows the site to assist you further based on your current location.
- D. **EIEGEND** Provides the symbology of what each symbol means.
- E. SUMMARY STATISTICS Displays counts per each crime classification. Results are interactively changing as the map extent is changing or as the data are filtered.
- F. **NEAR ME** Allows users to query information geographically. Enter your address or address of your interest and set a search radius (ft).

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G. **FILTER** Allows users to search for calls for service by city, hour of day and/or day of week OR limit information by date range or by call type. Make sure the ellipse shape on the right top corner to be green.



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- H. **INFORMATION** Get informed of the basic of the mapping application.
- I. BASEMAP GALLERY Switch between various basemap types or return to the default basemap at any time.
